## 'HIDDEN DISABILITIES' IN THE WORKPLACE

This conference will take an in-depth look at lesser known conditions that affect people in the workplace. The day will feature presentations from a range of eminent speakers, including Professor Else Guthrie on medically unexplained symptoms and Professor Cary Cooper on organisational psychology.

The day will also feature a session on dyslexia from Nicola Newman, a leading advisor on age and disability, as well as Dr Owen Bowden-Jones, Honorary Senior Lecturer at Imperial College London, sharing his wealth of experience on mental health difficulties.
