## QUALITY IMPROVEMENT

The Faculty's autumn conference is centred on quality improvement in healthcare, examining various quality improvement initiatives and schemes and how they can help occupational health physicians to improve the standard of their practice. The day will feature sessions on clinical audit, the benefits of lay input to professional bodies, and presentations on the experiences of implementing quality improvement in occupational health in two large organisations.

Niall Dickson, Chief Executive of the General Medical Council, will examine the role of revalidation in quality improvement; while David Behan, Chief Executive of the CQC, will be explaining the impact of the CQC on quality of care.

A session of three parallel, seminar-style workshops will take place in the afternoon where delegates will be given advice and guidance and have an opportunity for discussion. Delegates will be encouraged to actively participate and collaborate to explore the areas of their practice where they feel improvements can be made.

The day will finish with the presentation of the draft revised standards for SEQOHS, the Faculty's own successful and widely recognised quality improvement scheme. This session will be the final opportunity for comment and evaluation before the newly revised standards are published for implementation in 2015.

### **Health and Work Development Unit Lunchtime Demonstration**

The Health and Work Development Unit, a partnership between the Faculty of Occupational Medicine and the Royal College of Physicians (RCP), will be running a lunchtime demonstration on their National Quality Improvement Programme (NQIP). This programme of work contains national benchmarked clinical audits, an audit of record keeping and a client experience survey. The NQIP team will be demonstrating how OH services and individuals can make the most out of this programme to support their quality improvement work, achieve evidence for SEQOHS accreditation, and revalidation. Attendees will benefit from on-the day sign-up rates.
