Key health parameters for safety critical construction workers

The Faculty has been approached by colleagues working in construction health and safety, to ask if we would consider developing key parameters (eg cardiac health/blood pressure) for safety critical workers. The aim would be to establish a threshold, below which a worker might have to be excluded from safety critical work until the condition is brought under control.

Appraisals deadline for Revalidation

For all of those revalidating through the Faculty the deadline for completed appraisals in this first year is nearly upon us.

The Faculty, the Responsible Officer and the Society of Occupational Medicine have agreed that as long as the appraisal is fully arranged through the Society by **3** December 2013 then we will accept a delayed completion date. However, all 2012-2013 appraisals must be complete (including the additional questions) by 31 January 2014 at the very latest. An appraisal will of course be required during 2014 as well. This flexibility is intended to relieve pressure on appraisees and appraisers whilst ensuring that all doctors for whom the Faculty is responsible for making a revalidation recommendation fulfil the criteria for annual appraisal which started on 3 December 2012.
