NHS OH Survey—Deadline 31 March

I'm sure you'll already be aware of our survey which aims to assess the need for future training posts in occupational medicine. If not, its aim is simple: we are trying to map the number of OH Physician sessions provided to the NHS, because we are concerned that Health Education England may be basing decisions upon incorrect data about current NHS OH Physician manpower i.e. underestimating it.

So far the response rate to the survey is only 25%, and we would really like to encourage you to respond to the survey if you have not done so already. It is important that you reply, so that we can have some assurance of the completeness of our survey information. Therefore please reply even if you do not currently work in the NHS. The survey will only take less than a minute if you don't work in the NHS, and about 5-10 minutes if you do work sessions for the NHS.

Medical Fitness to Drive Survey—Reminder

We've teamed up with the National Programme Office for Traffic Medicine (Ireland) and the Irish FOM to carry out a survey of the opinion of occupational physicians on medical fitness to drive with a number of mental health conditions and alcohol dependence and abuse.

Given the slender evidence base upon which to support decision-making, we are trying to tap into the collective wisdom of expert clinicians, who in general try to balance mobility and safety in due proportion, given the importance of driving as a central aspect of modern life.

A short **SurveyMonkey** has been created to gather your thoughts on the matter. The survey should take less than 5 minutes and all responses are anonymous. Responses will be accepted until **Monday 4th April 2016**, and we are very grateful in advance for your participation in this project which will help to inform practice.
