



MFOM Part 2 OSCE Blueprint

The MFOM Part 2 Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) tests the clinical and communication skills underpinning independent specialist occupational medicine practice in the UK within the context of the NHS, the independent provider sector and the military.

A total of twelve clinical stations will be run. The duration of each OSCE station will be ten minutes. The stations will be structured across the following four areas:

- History taking
- Examination
- Explanation
- Procedures

The skills required for each OSCE station will be mapped to the OMST 2022 Curriculum Learning Outcomes as indicated in the tables below.
