EGM: Becoming an Incorporated Charity

Members were notified on 1st September of the Board's intention for the Faculty to become an incorporated charity, and the draft Memorandum and Articles of Association were posted on the website. Notification was also given of an Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) to be held on 1st December.

This is to confirm that the EGM will be held at 12 noon on 1st December at the Royal College of Physicians, 11 St Andrews Place, London NW1. The subject will be the change to incorporated status.

Since 1st September the Faculty Board has further reviewed the draft Memorandum and Articles of Association and made a small number of changes. A revised draft is now available at <u>www.facoccmed.ac.uk/library/docs/m-adraftnov10.pdf</u> which incorporates these changes. The preamble to the document indicates where changes have been made.

The EGM will consider this updated version.
